MILESTONES & AWARDS

- 1943** — John M. McKenney opens shop south of Atlanta to recap tires for the Army during World War II.
- 1948** — McKenney's Tire & Appliance begins selling household appliances, shifting from residential to light industrial and commercial work. On June 4, 1948, the company officially becomes *McKenney's, Inc.*
- 1952** — McKenney's begins taking on larger projects, including multi-story commercial and residential work.
- 1972** — Opens new headquarters in the heart of Atlanta. McKenney's transitions to second-generation leadership as John M. McKenney's son David joins the company.
- 1991** — Opens an office in Charlotte, North Carolina.
- 1997** — David McKenney's son John joins McKenney's. John serves as McKenney's CEO to this day.
- 2006** — Voted one of Atlanta's Best Places to work - an award repeated 9 other years in Atlanta, as well as in Charlotte.
- 2007** — Headquarters installs a 10,000 gallon rainwater recycling tank, along with 221 solar panels capable of producing over 70,000 kW hours of electricity annually.
- 2015** — Winner of the MCAA Safety Excellence Award, for safety programs & initiatives that ensure employees' health and safety.
- 2016** — Surpasses 2.5 million man-hours worked on various projects.
- 2020** — Works on expansions for one of the world's largest data centres in spite of the COVID-19 pandemic.
